

Update 23rd July 2021

Following on from the next phase in the lifting of COVID restrictions, the PCC have met and agreed a way forward.

From this Sunday - July 25th, for both our 09.30 and 11.15 services, you will be able to enter St Paul's using either entrance and we will no longer be taking details for track and trace. We do ask, if you are able, that you still wear a mask when entering and leaving and that you sanitise your hands on arrival.

In church, you will have a choice of sitting in socially distanced pews (south aisles - to the left as you face the altar) or unmarked pews (north aisles). Once seated in the unmarked pews or soft chairs, please feel free to remove your mask. We would ask that those who choose to sit in socially distanced pews, continue wearing their masks.
We are able to sing! Hallelujah!

For the 09.30 service, at communion, the choir will receive first, followed by those socially distanced wearing masks, followed by those who have elected not to wear a mask. Communion will be prepared as before but we will now eat the bread as we receive it before moving to receive the wine (still in individual cups).

Other arrangements at 09.30 will stay the same for now: the peace, collection, reading of the gospel from the lectern. We hope to re-introduce servers and tea and coffee after the service in September. Similar arrangements will be in place for our 6.30 service at St Lawrence although all tape has been removed.
